Mr. Abdiwahab Abdullahi Abdi joins the Salaries and Remuneration Commission as a new Commissioner

Thursday, 25 November 2021, Nairobi: In exercise of the powers conferred by Article 230(2)(a) of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010, and in accordance with the procedure set out in Section 7(13) of the Salaries and Remuneration Commission Act, 2011, President Uhuru Kenyatta appointed Mr. Abdiwahab Abdullahi Abdi as a Member of the Salaries and Remuneration Commission (SRC).

Mr. Abdiwahab was sworn in yesterday at the Supreme Court of Kenya by Chief Justice Martha Koome, joining SRC as a representative of the Judicial Service Commission.

Previously, Mr. Abdiwahab worked for the International Centre for Participatory Health and Environmental Research as a consultant in the field of baseline studies and needs assessment.
